## The Streak of Consecutive Seasons with at least I school over 501+ Points Continues

Why wait for the playoffs...
Northwest Missouri has been scoring at will during the 2011 season; and as a result of its 52-21 victory over Missouri Southern this past weekend...raised the Bearcats' total to 505 points-in 9 games.

In doing so, the school became the $12^{\text {th }}$ team to have reached the $500+$ Plateau in the ninth game of a respective season-and just the second NCAA II team-to accomplish in this many games.

Without playing another game, the school from Maryville has outscored the famed 1944 Army unit which feature "Mr. Inside (Doc Blanchard) and Mr. Outside (Glenn Davis) as their featured backs.

* This accomplishment by Northwest Missouri gives the school its $9^{\text {th }} 500+$ Season; tying it for second all-time in most seasons to have reached this mark with Nebraska. It is also the fifth consecutive season for that the Bearcats have surpassed this mark—tying it for second with Sioux Falls.

Mount Union is the all-time leader in consecutive seasons with 16; beginning in 1993.

Since the 1885 season with Princeton tallied 645 points (also in 9 games) there have been 176 college football teams that have surpassed 500+ points in a single-season. (There have been 422 accomplishments.)

With 2 regular season games (and quite possibly the NCAA D2 post-season) the Bearcats have a chance to add to its 509 points, which currently ranks as the $383^{\text {rd }}$ highest of all-time (since the 1883 season when scoring values went into effect)—as it is tied with six other schools-all that played in at least 12 games over a full season.
