Lucky 13: Thirteen Teams Pile on the Points-having scored at least 500 Points
Shippensburg, a NCAA II team, has scored a team all-time high of 595 points and is currently the highest scoring team in 2012; one of six first-time teams to surpass the 500+ point plateau in a single-season.

The first touchdown the school scores in the second round of the NCAA II playoffs will push the school inside a select group of ( 96 to be exact) of ones that have tallied 600-837 points.

Another newcomer and perennial high-scoring team, Southern Oregon and Mount Union currently rank as the $113^{\text {th }}$ highest scoring team in college football stathistory/500+Rankings.

These two teams have put 589 points on the scoreboards as well as playing in the same number of games, 12 .

Louisiana Tech, with its season finale to be played this coming Saturday, round out the 2012 teams in the Top 150 all time (circa 1885...Princeton, [645 645 points during a $9-0$ season.])

Though it's unlikely, that LT would fail to score this weekend, it will remain tied with 3 other schools-and it would be the third year-in-a-row that a team has scored 575 points. (Teams: 1949-College of Pacific; 2010-Oklahoma State and 2011- Boise State.) LT's could also extend its tally if it receives a bowl bid.
