# Weekly Updates of College Football Teams Scoring

As college football fans know, the object of any games is to score the most points; and with that a team their team can be declared the winner.

The 1885 season produced the first of now 484 accomplishments of a team scoring over 500+ points in a single-season.

Of that total, just one school has been proficient in putting up points on the scoreboard like no other throughout the stathistory of the game.

Mount Union first tallied 500 or more points in 19 season-the last 18 consecutive.

This past weekend—and over the two games prior-the Purple Raiders continued to set the bar on accomplishments by teams Lighting-up the Scoreboard!

This school has been on a scoring sensation during the NCAA III Playoffs. After ending the regular season with just it fourth time scoring over 500 or more points-517 in 10 games.

UMU opened its quest for the school's $11^{\text {th }}$ National Championship with a 7214 triumph over Christopher Newport; bumping its season total to 589.

The following week, the Purple Raiders became one of six schools to go from scoring over 500...increasing the total to at least 600 points in back-to-back games.

As a new month of action began last Saturday; one thing remained constantMount Union finding the end zone.

For the second time in three weeks (and third time in its history), as Mount Union would light-up the scoreboard like it was a Christmas Tree-putting 72 points on the home side tally! (A missed PAT prevented the team from establishing its post-season high.)

The 72 -scoring outburst valued the high-scoring offense to 716 points; thus becoming the first team to register enough points to surpass 500-600-700 in successive weekends.

> Twenty-five other colleges have tallied over 500 points in 2012; marking the eighth time at least 20 teams have topped this plateau-all since 2000.

There has been nine first year teams during the current campaign, matching the 2005 tally and 4 from the standard of 13 set a year ago, when 36 teamsalso a single-season high-produced a point producing offense.

Eight teams have ended their season.

## - Highlighting from within the 26 teams 500+ Teams reveals...

--Morningside (Iowa) enters the NAIA National Championship Game with 591 points- $13^{\text {h }}$ highest of 28 [18 \#1s] teams that have participated in this association's title game.
--Mount Union's current tally of 716 points is tied with 2008 Oklahoma for the $10^{\text {th }}$ highest scoring team in 500+point stathistory.
--Ranked $47^{\text {th }}$ all-time is Mary Hardin-Baylor, scoring 650 points; this ties 2004 NCAA III National Champion Linfield-which played 14 contests that season.
--First time scoring 500 points was Southern Oregon; in 14 games and its season over, the team is in a three-way tie for $61^{\text {st }}$.
--Louisiana Tech is the highest ranked BSD team— $78^{\text {th }}$-with 618 points; however, its season is over.
--Oregon's high-flying offense is next, at $89^{\text {th }}$, tailing LT by just 8 points
--Shippensburg closes-out its initial 500+points season with 609 points; $92^{\text {nd }}$ all-time.
