

Two-time NAIA National Champion, Sioux Falls' won its 37th consecutive game, a 28-3 victory over Morningside (Iowa); to pull even with Augustana IL's 37 straight wins, between 1983-85.

The victory also ties the school with Southern University (Louisiana) for the 9th most small college consecutive games without a loss.

Augustana would add to the previously mentioned 37 straight without a setback; as the team compiled 60 (59-0-1) games without a setback—the all time divisional leader.

Following Augustana's current is current perennial powerhouse, Mount Union's streak of 55 straight in a four-year span, beginning in 2000. The Purple Raiders won a game-less from 1996-99; which tied Morgan State's 54 consecutive games without a setback from 1931-38 as they won 47 games with 7 ties.

Grand Valley State, a NCAA II school, has the standard for the current streak, winning 40 straight over three seasons, from 2005-07.

The last time Sioux Falls tasted defeat was in the **2007 NAIA National Championship Game** (17-9 vs Carroll Montana); and is playing in its final season in the NAIA and will move to NCAA II in 2011.

Sioux Falls' last setback came in the 2007 NAIA Championship Game against Carroll.
