Boise State and Nevada...19 teams highlight this week's Lighting-up the Scoreboard

Not only did Friday night's game between Boise State and Nevada provide college football fans with a thrilling and dramatic contest; it also pitted a pair of teams that have scored at least 500+Points in 2010.

These two teams are with 9 points of each other; with Nevada winning this margin as well, 519-510.

For the second time in three weeks, St. Xavier handed St. Francis a setback; this time the teams met in round two of the 57th annual NAIA Playoffs.

St. X's put 40 points on the scoreboard which increased its tally for the 2010 season 675 points—78 points ahead of NCAA III Wisconsin-Whitewater; which scored 69 in its second round playoff victory, good for second in this week's standings.

Three teams enter this week's weekly rankings of 500+ teams, a NCAA II team and a pair of Bowl SubDivision teams for the first time.

Central Missouri's 542 is tied for the 71st highest of teams scoring 500+Points for the first time, tying Emory & Henry VA, NCAA III (1987) and New Hampshire, NCAA 1-AA (2005).

TCU and Wisconsin have been scoring at-will during the 2010 season—currently at 520 points—and to date, (they are currently tied Abilene Christian in the all-time rankings) one another at No. 105—one spot back of McPherson Kansas (which tied Lindenwood's 2008 total.

But, the leader of all first-year 500+ teams is Trine, a NCAA III. The school ended its season over the weekend; but its 521 points is tied with 1981 Southwest Texas State, for the 57th spot.

Once again, St. Xavier II is the nation's highest scoring team as the team advances into the NAIA's Semi-Final Playoff Round.

The Cougars have tallied 665 point thus far during the 2010 season; which places them in a tie for the 24th highest scoring team in college football StatHistory/schools scoring at least 500+ Points. (St. X is tied with Trinity TX's 2002 tally.)

Rounding 2010 out the Top 5—seperated by just 32 points include: 587 Mary Hardin-Baylor; 577 Lindenwood; 555 Oregon; 554 Trine

Last week, Sioux Falls kept is streak alive when it scored its 505th point. The Cougars have now scored reached the 500+ Plateau in five consecutive seasons—history's third highest.

St. Francis, Ind. is second with 7 straight (200-08); with Mount Union is far and away the all-time leader with 15 straight, beginning in 1995.

But, wait, you don't see the Purple Raiders listed in the current standings...this was not a typo; the '10 Mount Union eleven is 14 points from extending its streak.
