Worth Noting: Oregon is 78 points from tying St. Xavier; but I think it is safe to say, that the Ducks may come close to the 670, without surpassing it *(stay tuned and find out!)*

Each year the list of schools "Lighting-up the Scoreboard" continues to add new teams; 8 first-time teams made the list for 2010.

This brings the total to 175 schools that have recorded at least a single 500+ Season. (A lot of the "National" known BSD powerhouses ARE NOT included.)

The BCS Championship Game isn't the only remaining game the pits a pair of teams scoring 500+ Points meeting.

The Granddaddy of Bowl Games ® the Rose Bowl will have a pair of the previously mentioned first-time teams over 500+.

TCU and Wisconsin are not only apair of schools to make their debut on the list this season, but the schools are currently tied as the 108th highest scoring first-time team—as each have tallied 520 points (**AND** are *within a point* of tying another first-year school, McPherson KS.)
